



Diploma in Education and Training (DET)

Validated by Canterbury Christ Church University

Part-time evening course over 2 years at Uxbridge College

This course is run in partnership with Canterbury Christ Church University. The University's post-compulsory teacher training provision was graded 'Outstanding' by Ofsted in March 2014. At Uxbridge College, the provision has been well-established with consistently high success rates, e.g. 100% in 2016-18.

Entry requirements

- A qualification in your subject area (minimum Level 3 for skills subjects or a degree for academic subjects)
- A regular class or classes of **groups** (not 1:1 though can be a mix as long as there is sufficient group teaching) that you can teach during the programme in your qualified subject area amounting to minimum of 100 independent teaching hours over 2 years (usually split into 40 hours in Year 1 and 60 in Year 2). **Arrangement of this is the applicant's responsibility.**
- A subject mentor in your institution
- A good command of spoken and written English

CCCU (Canterbury Christ Church University) DET (Level 5) with ProfGCE (Professional Graduate Certificate in Education Level 6)

This is a University validated DET. Year 1 is at Level 4 and Year 2 is at Level 5, **but for those with degrees who have the capability of working at Level 6 or above, the ProfGCE pathway will be available.** It is a part-time, two-year in-service course with one attendance every week which aims to develop the knowledge, skills and understanding of teachers and trainers working in Further Education Colleges, Adult and Community Learning, 14-19 units in Schools and Academies, Private Training Organisations, Prison Education and the Public services (Police, Paramedics, Fire Service). Assessment is through a portfolio of evidence which includes observations, reflections, presentations and written work. There are 6 modules of study: Year 1, Module 1: Introduction to Teaching and Learning, Module 2: Enhancing Teaching and Learning, Module 3: The Learner and Learner Progress, Year 2, Module 4: Reflecting on Practice, Module 5: Innovating the Curriculum, Module 6: Developing Practice. English, Maths and SEN Specialist Pathways are also available. On completion, there is an accreditation route to QTLS (Qualified Teacher Learning and Skills) status.

Fee: £2,700 per year + £30 admin fee (Student loans are available through Student Finance)
