Do I already need to have a job?

You should be working a minimum of 30 hours per week in a job. If you are unemployed, view our vacancies to apply for a job: www.uxbridgecollege.ac.uk/apprenticeships

Can I start an apprenticeship after Year 11?

Yes, you can! Young people in England must stay in education or training until they turn 18. If you're looking for a different option after Year 11, an apprenticeship could be the answer for you!

How long does it take to complete an apprenticeship?

You can complete an apprenticeship between 12 to 18 months,

depending on your experience, competence and the sector you are working in.

How much does it cost?

There is no cost for you to do an apprenticeship if you are 16-23 years old and you will be paid a wage.

How am I assessed?

Assessments are carried out in your workplace. Our assessor will come and assess you in your job role.

What's next after I complete my apprenticeship?

Further Study -

On successful completion of a Level 2 Apprenticeship, you may progress to a Level 3 Apprenticeship or similar qualification. Some apprenticeships are now available at Level 4, the equivalent to a Foundation Degree.

Career opportunities -

Many apprentices are taken on full-time at their work place. Others have boosted their CVs with job-related experience and gone on to develop their career in other companies.
