Tuition fees:	free for home students
Examination fee:	no charge
College registration fee:	no charge

Full-Time Further Education Courses - Students aged 19+	
Tuition fees:	Varies based on your prior education level and employment status. If you are working or self-employed and earn below the annual London Living Wage of £20,572.50 (£16,009.50 if you are an outer London resident) you may qualify for free tuition fees. ESOL courses are eligible for free tuition and many other subject areas at Entry Level, Level 1 and Level 2 are too. You will need to provide evidence of your earnings (wage slips or a current contract with details of your earnings) when you come to enrol . There may be other costs you do need to pay for (eg exam fees, materials costs and trips) depending on your course.
Examination fee:	varies depending on your course
College registration fee:	£35
ID cards:	£5

Part-Time Courses - All Students	
Tuition fees:	Varies based on your prior education level and employment status. If you are over 19 years old, working or self-employed and earn below the annual London Living Wage of £20,572.50 (£16,009.50 if you are an outer London resident) you may qualify for free tuition fees. ESOL courses are eligible for free tuition and many other subject areas at Entry Level, Level 1 and Level 2 are too. You will need to provide evidence of your earnings (wage slips or a current contract with details of your earnings) when you come to enrol . There may be other costs you do need to pay for (eg exam fees, materials costs and trips) depending on your course.
