



Level 2 Award in Support in Schools 2020-2021

Award in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools, City and Guilds

This is a basic, initial course for those wishing to become a Teaching Assistant in schools or Further Education. It is also suitable for those who are already working in a school and looking to progress.

Units include:

- Unit 201: Child and young person development
- Unit 202: Safeguarding the welfare of children and young people
- Unit 203: Communication and professional relationships with children, young people and adults
- Unit 204: Equality, diversity and inclusion in work with children and young people
- Unit 205: Schools as organisations

Entry criteria

No previous experience is required but Level 2 English reading and writing skills are necessary.

There is an **initial literacy assessment** prior to acceptance onto the course.

Use of computer

Your work will be presented and assessed in an electronic portfolio (training will be given) so access to a computer and Internet is **absolutely essential**.

Dates and fees

This is a **daytime** course on the **Uxbridge Campus**. 100% attendance is required.

Wednesday mornings, 10 am – 12 noon, 2 hours per week for 15 weeks

Total Course Fee: £385, payable prior to start date
